<u>Keeping Things in Per-Spectrum: Next Generation Technology and Opportunities for Smart</u> <u>Cities and Entrepreneurs</u>

Experts discuss challenges and incentives for cities and communities that are stimulating the deployment of advanced telecommunications technologies. Issues include unlicensed spectrum, the upcoming Citizens Broadband Radio Service (CBRS) auctions, and allocation schemes designed to reduce spectrum shortage. What exactly is "smart deregulation," and how can we ensure that it benefits communities of color and other underrepresented populations? What are the dangers of deregulation, and how do we protect vulnerable communities from them? The panel will discuss drivers such as spectrum, infrastructure-friendly policies, and public-private partnerships for the successful deployment of new technologies.
